

Coach - ACT Youth Cup Team

Purpose

To coach the ACT Youth Cup Team, provide guidance in the development of the ACT Youth Cup rowers and broaden the participation rate at the base level of ACT elite rowing.

Responsibilities

- Direct the activities of the rowers within the team to ensure the team is fully prepared to compete at the Youth Cup Regatta.
- Develop, implement and keep training programs relating to the preparation of the team.
- Be responsible for occupational, health and safety and environmental management matters relating to the team.
- Provide guidance to the members of the team on introducing the rowers to elite style training, rower education and representative team commitment.
- Provide care and support to the team during training, camps and competition.
- Communicate effectively with individual athletes' coaches regarding training and expectations.

Issues and Challenges

Managing a team of rowers in meeting the diverse and often competing demands of rowing clubs and individuals.

Decision Making and Accountability

This position is a ACTRA coach. The job holder is required to work largely unsupervised and is accountable for:

• The quality of work and performance standards in ensuring the Youth Team meets ACTRA needs.

- Ensuring well informed technical judgements are made in coaching decisions that deliver performance and in ensuring OH&S standards are met.
- Effective planning for, and conduct of, team training, camps and competition.

Job Dimension

This position reports to ACTRA Head Coach.

As coach you will be responsible for 10 youth rowers and assist with the care and support of the rest of the team.

Key Result Areas

- Well documented training programs.
- Rowers are equipped to perform at optimum level at the Youth Cup Regatta.
- Rowers have a better understanding and appreciation of representative team rowing.

<u>Aims</u>

- Team finishes among the top 3 Australian teams.
- Team wins 8+ event at the Youth Cup Regatta.

Selection criteria

- Minimum Level 1 NCAS Rowing accreditation or overseas equivalent
- Understands the aspects of rower development and providing guidance in elite rowing pathways.
- Demonstrated performance of athletes
- A well developed understanding of OH&S relating to ACT rowing.
- Able to lead and motivate rowers.
- Able to plan and carry out multiple tasks while coaching to tight dead lines.
- Able to work independently and as a team member.
- Reliable, self motivated and fully committed to ACTRA representative teams.
