Rowing Queensland (RQ) with the support of the Queensland Academy of Sport (QAS), Rowing Australia (RA) and the Australian Institute of Sport (AIS), is seeking a full-time scholarship coach to develop the next generation of QLD Olympic Rowers. Our role is to identify and develop talent through the Rowing Australia Performance Pathway, for underage national team representation and progressing more athletes into the National Training Centres.

With the 2032 Olympic Games being held in Brisbane. RQ has identified a great opportunity for this position to be part of the – Generation 2032 Coaching Program. The program is delivered by the QAS in partnership with the AIS, with the aim of developing more performance coaches within our QLD pathway leading towards Brisbane 2032. The position will be employed by RQ and seconded to QAS for program operations, personal development and coaching duties.

Duties:

- Enrolment and engagement with the Generation 2032 Coaching Program, delivered by the QAS.
- Working under the direction and expectations of the QAS Head Coach to deliver coaching and support to all water and land sessions of the QAS rowing program comprising of podium to emerging categorised athletes and training partners.
- Oversee the operational requirements of the QAS boat shed, boat fleet and other training equipment needs.
- In consultation with QAS Head Coach, attend all underage event requirements & camps set out by Rowing Australia and QAS/RQ.
- In consultation with Rowing Queensland's High Performance & Development Manager and QAS Head Coach, design and implement training and monitoring programs to support Queensland Pathway Structure.
- Maintain and foster strong relationships within RQ, QAS and RA.
